



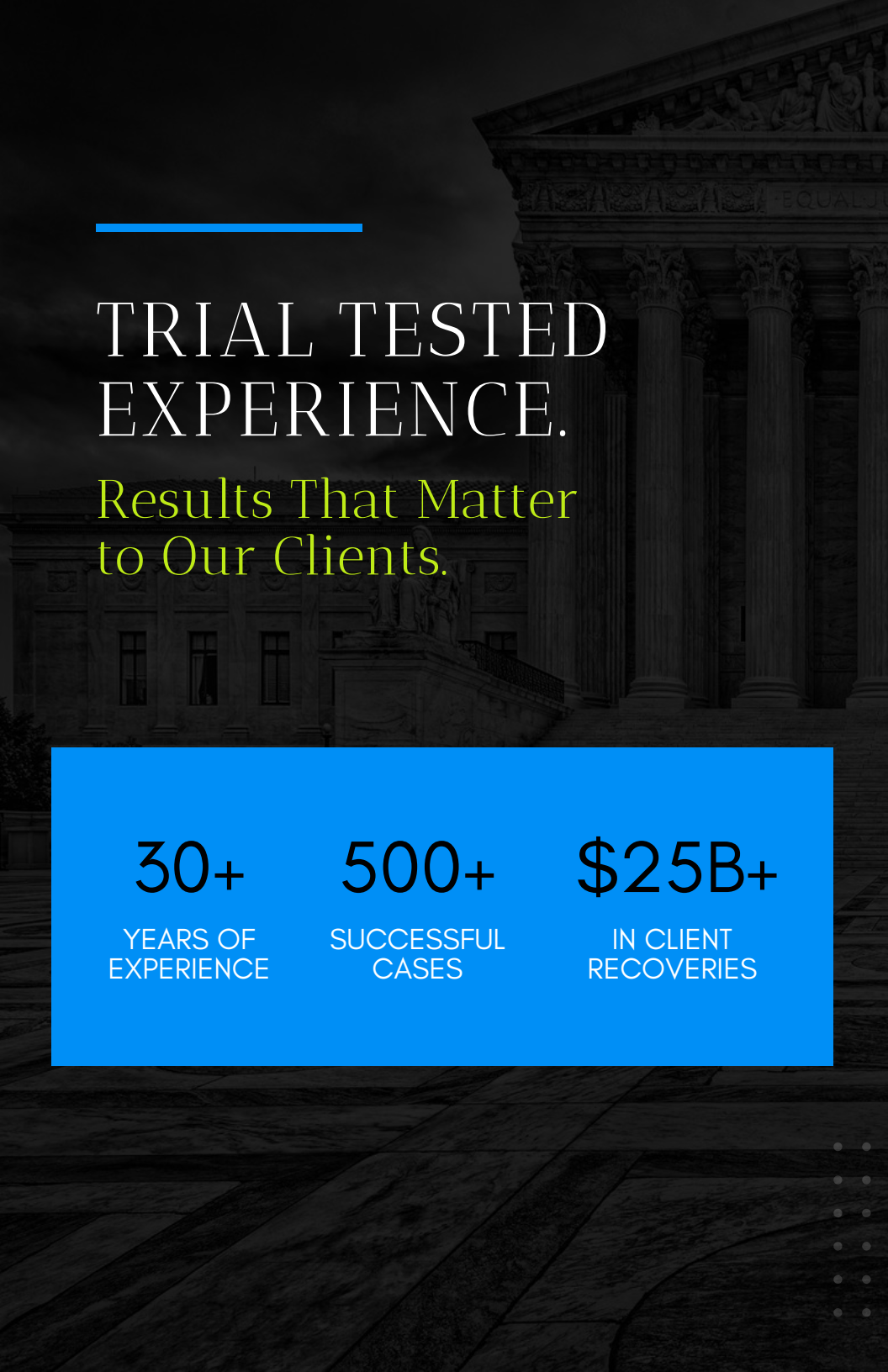

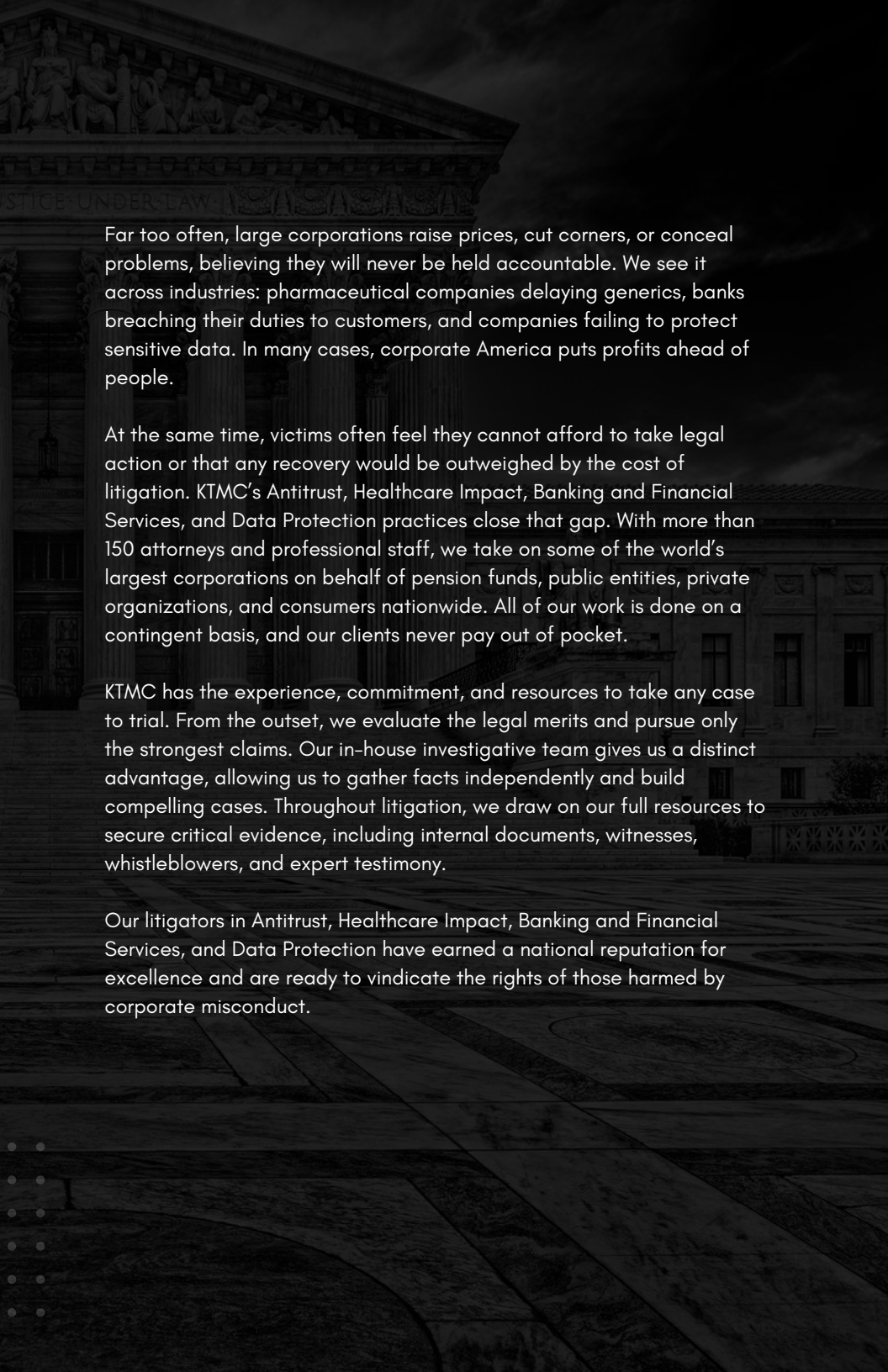

We litigate under federal and state antitrust laws to challenge collusion, market manipulation, and abuse of regulatory systems.

KTMC is a leader in pharmaceutical antitrust litigation, targeting reverse-payment schemes, delayed generic entry, and other practices that drive up drug prices.
