The *Super Micro Computer, Inc.* class action lawsuits were filed on behalf of those who purchased or otherwise acquired *Super Micro Computer, Inc.* ("*Super Micro*") (NASDAQ: SMCI) securities between February 2, 2024 and March 19, 2026, inclusive (the "Class Period"). The *Super Micro* class action lawsuits allege that *Super Micro* and/or certain of its officers and/or directors violated federal securities laws by making false or misleading statements and/or omitted to disclose material information.

COMPLAINT ALLEGATION SUMMARY:

The complaints allege that, throughout the Class Period, Defendants made materially false and/or misleading statements, as well as failed to disclose material facts about the company's business, operations, and prospects. Specifically, Defendants misrepresented and/or failed to disclose that: (1) a significant portion of the company's sales of servers were to companies based in China, with these transactions violating U.S. export control laws; (2) *Super Micro* lacked adequate controls to ensure compliance with applicable export control laws and regulations; and (3) as a result of the foregoing, Defendants' statements about the company's business, operations, and prospects were materially false and misleading and/or lacked a reasonable basis at all relevant times.

WHY DID SUPER MICRO'S STOCK DROP?

On March 19, 2026, the U.S. Justice Department announced the unsealing of an indictment against three people associated with *Super Micro* for taking part in an effort to "divert massive quantities of servers housing U.S. artificial intelligence technology to customers in China." On this news, *Super Micro*'s stock price fell 33.3%.



THE LEAD PLAINTIFF PROCESS:

The Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995 permits any investor who purchased or acquired *Super Micro* securities during the Class Period to seek appointment as lead plaintiff in the *Super Micro* class action lawsuit. A lead plaintiff is a representative party that acts on behalf of other class members in directing the litigation. In order to be appointed lead plaintiff, the Court must determine that the class member's claim is typical of the claims of other class members, and that the class member will adequately represent the class. Your ability to share in any recovery is not, however, affected by the decision whether or not to serve as a lead plaintiff. Filling out the online form above or communicating with any counsel is not necessary to participate or share in any recovery achieved in this case. Any member of the purported class may move the court to serve as a lead plaintiff through counsel of his/her choice, or may choose to do nothing and remain an inactive class member.
